About CRDT

Vision: A Cambodia free from poverty and environmental degradation.

Mission: Sustainably improve food security, incomes, and living standards of poor rural communities in support of environmental conservation in Cambodia.

The Cambodian Rural Development Team (CRDT) is a Cambodian development NGO which aims to lift communities out of poverty in support of conservation through participatory community based approaches. CRDT aims at improving food security and income generation of the poor by transforming their unsustainable subsistence living into sustainable livelihoods through mobilizing, empowering and organizing community groups to actively develop local social-economic status. CRDT is implementing various integrated community development projects on environmentally appropriate agricultural development, increasing food security, supporting market linkages and income generation, social enterprises, environmental education, climate change adaptation, water and sanitation, renewable energy technologies, eco-tourism, and community empowerment.

CRDT was registered with the Ministry of Interior as a Cambodian NGO on June 25th, 2005. We have since then been working in the North-East of Cambodia, covering the provinces of Stung Treng, Kratie and Monduliri. CRDT's Head Office is located in the town of Kratie. We are offering both volunteer and internship opportunities to graduates/undergraduates in the following or related fields:

1. **Agriculture** (preferably linked to agri-business, or marketing, agronomy, horticulture): one placement based in Keo Seima, Monduliri Province
2. **Community Research** (preferably linked to agriculture, food security and income generations): one placement based in Stung Treng Town, Stung Treng Province
3. **Monitoring and Evaluation, Data Collection:** one placement based in Kratie town, Kratie Province

Requirements:

- Be a graduate/undergraduate in one of the above or related fields
- Be available for at least 3 months; there are possibilities to be extended or to be transferred to CRDT staff
- Starting date: as soon as possible
- Sound knowledge and commitment to the promotion of sustainable agriculture, community empowerment, and environmental conservation in Cambodia
- Good communication and interpersonal skills
- Good English with a proven ability at speaking and writing
- Placement locations: Kratie, Stung Treng, or Monduliri

Allowances provided:

- Food allowance of USD 80 per month
- Accommodation in the field offices.
- During the placements, travel and other expenses for work purposes will be covered by CRDT in line with our organizational and financial policies.
